

SPANISH ATHLETICS CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE 2012 · XVI MEETING BASAURIKO PROBAK · BASAURI, 8-10 JUNE 2012

COMPETITION RULES

1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The **Spanish Athletics Championships for Disabled People 2012** will take place in Polideportivo Artunduaga in Basauri.

The **Spanish Athletics Championships for Disabled People 2012** – will be organised by Spanish Sports Federation for People with Cerebral Palsy (FEDPC), Spanish Federation of Sports for People with Physical Disabilities (FEDDF), Spanish Sports Federation for People with Intellectual Disabilities and Spanish Federation of Sports for the Blind (FEDC).

The competition will take place from the **8th to the 10th of June 2012**.

2. PROGRAMME

3. RULES

Conditions for participating

Must prove they have a license issued by International Paralympic Committee (IPC) - Athletics.

Minimum age to participate in the tournament is 16 years old. Younger participants will only be allowed upon receipt of a personal invitation from the LOC.

Competition

This competition will be ruled according to the International Amateur Athletics Federation's (IAAF) rules and the specific rules of the IPC Athletics.

The competition program for the championship includes the following events for the categories and classes detailed below:

No official event will take place without a minimum of 3 competitors. If such an event takes place with less than 3 participants, it will only be taken into account to validate obtained marks.

For the 100, 200 and 400 m, category T11-T12, which will take place in 8 lane tracks, the best four classifications will pass on to finals if a guide is needed. If no such circumstance occurs, the final will be disputed amongst all possible athletes until completion of 8 lanes, guides included.

Article 14: Relays:

For 10 sport classes: Composition of mixed teams will be at least one T11 and a maximum of three T12 athletes.

For 30 sport classes: Composition of mixed teams must only include category T35-T38, it is not allowed to overcome 147 points in the sum of classes.

During field competition events 8 athletes will pass on to the improvement event. Improvement events will be performed according to indications by the judge of each event.

For jumping competitions, the poles will be arranged in the following manner:

For throwing competitions except for classes T11, T12 and T13, points will be awarded according to IPC tables for the period in question.

For throwing from a fixed chair (F31-F34, F51-F58), throws will be performed consecutively.

Each athlete may participate in a maximum of three events and two relays. Any inscription which doesn't comply with this criteria will not be admitted.

The competition will be controlled by judges adscribed to the regional Judge Committee. Admitting in this case, National judges from FEDPC for the specific events for this disability which aren't included in the IPC programme. These judges may also be national judges by the RFEA.

The organiser must provide regulation facilities and material.

For competitions which take place on tracks made of synthetic material, athletes who compete wearing trainers with spikes, or in their absence a resting surface with spikes on the carbon foot, are obliged to make these spikes no longer than 6 mm. or the statutory length dictated by IAAF to this purpose.

All participating athletes must wear their numbers in the manner established by the organisation.

During a championship or competitions an athlete may be excluded from participating in one or more events, if having been classified, in eliminatory or in series, he doesn't participate in the next event, or also, having confirmed his inscription he doesn't participate without a justified cause.

Those sportsmen who after having passed the corresponding ophthalmology examination for visually disabled, and physical examination—functional in the case of sportsmen with physical disabilities or brain paralysis, either in IBSA, IWAS, CP-ISRA, IPC competitions or in FEDPC, FEDC, and FEDDF competitions, and who have classified in any of the disability categories, must remain in their category until passing a new examination of a superior nature to the one established.

Athletes in need of a guide, must request a runner in their inscription form, including their personal mark, as well as the mark the guide must have. These athletes must also use a rope which maintains the union between both of them.

12 (B2) athletes won't be able to participate in guided races without permission from LOC.

4. PRIZES

The first three (3) spanish athletes classified from each event (once the class combinations have been performed), out of which the 1st will be National Champion, will receive corresponding medals, golden for the 1st, silver for the 2nd and bronze for the 3rd.

Medals award ceremony will only take place for those events which after the class combinations and trophy award, have athletes in first, second and third place.

Only when a foreign athlete classified first in a event, will receive a trophy.

5. INSCRIPTION

First, athletes and staff personal carry out the preinscription in the LOC web: http://www.basaurimeeting.com/web/index.php?option=com_content&view=frontpage&Itemid=1&lang=es . Athletes must mark in website the event record in each one which they are inscribed. Inscription will be formalized once the LOC send you the confirmation of the fulfilled preinscription. The final inscription date will end on **29nd of May 2012**.

Sport inscription for NPC athletes from foreign countries will be free per event in which is inscribed.

Every inscription application which is not completed within the established period will be excluded to all effects. Once the inscription period has finished no change in participant (athlete or technician/staff) will be accepted, with the exception of major causes duly justified.

Non-observation of any of the points of these rules or lack of veracity in inscription data will be a motive for non-acceptance by the affected organising committee, irrespective of ulterior responsibilities which may then be derived.

6. INTERNATIONAL CLASSIFICATION PANEL

There will be a complete International Classification Panel present at the event for Visual classification the 8th June.

7. ACCOMODATION AND TRANSPORT

LOC proposes accommodation offers to the participants who ask for them.

Furthermore, there will be shuttle transport to the airport and between accommodation and sport facilities.

8. COMPETITION COMMITTEE AND APPEAL COMMITTEE

The competition committee is made up of two representatives from each Spanish Federation for disabled people (FEDC, FEDPC, FEDDI y FEDDF).

This Committee will decide on: complaints, calendar modifications, invalidation of those events where circumstances of favour or other circumstances esteemed convenient.

Every protest or complaint will follow the prosecution established in IAFF rules

1st Verbal complaint of Athlete to the Judge of the event

2ne Verbal complaint of the athlete or his representative to the Championship Referee Judge

3rd Written complaint to the appeal jury.

The appeal committee will be formed at the championship.



The complaint presented to the appeal jury must be in writing and signed by the athlete's representative and accompanied by 70 €. If the appeal is not persuasive the appellant will lose the deposited amount.

The Competition Committee will decide on questions which arise during the event and will resolve all complaints which are officially filed. Complaints regarding technical questions, the appeal Committee ends the federative route.

9. FINAL DISPOSITIONS

The organising committee of national Athletics Championships will not be responsible for material or personal damages which may take place under any concept or participant or his material or another person.

The organising committee will reserve the right to alter any organisational aspect of the National Championships, as long as it results in some benefit to the said Championships.

The organising committee, acting through the technical director of the competitions will interpret the present rules and norms to be applied during the championship.

The rules reflected in the present document automatically overrule previous rules concerning National Championships.

10. UNFORESEEN EVENTS

FEDPC, FEDDF, FEDDI and FEDDC retain the ability to perform at any time the necessary changes according to the criterion of the Championship organising committee.
